The generosity of the churches is focused upon strengthening our churches in San Angelo and in the surrounding counties. The association is growing in the number of partnering churches as we connect with rural congregations in areas where associations have ceased to exist.

Thank you for your faithfulness and let us continue in the truth and our faithfulness to the gospel.
