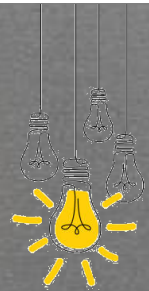

Dear Church family,

I'm writing to share what most of you are already aware of. We lost a long-time deacon, and active church member in Sammy Farmer. Sammy loved Immanuel Baptist Church. He grew up just down the street from the church building and through thick and thin, he pointed people to Jesus. For nearly 20 years he led a men's group at the Charcoal House on North Chadbourne. In years past, Sammy was always a volunteer for children and youth camps where he led many young men to trust Jesus Christ as their Lord and savior. As a close friend of my fathers, and the man that brought Dr. Orand over to my parents' house in 1979, which led my father to the Lord and to IBC, the Farmer's have always been close friends to my family and to me personally. I'll always be grateful for Sammy intentionally drawing closer to me when my own father died three years ago. He was still at it trying to get people to Jesus just days ago when he asked me to make several promises about reaching out and share Jesus with others. Sammy was a Kingdom man, and he made a difference.

We will hold a visitation for the family next Tuesday, January 27th in the gym 4:00-7:00 p.m. We will hold a Memorial Service the following day, January 28th at 10:00 a.m. We will have an overflow space available in the Student Center across the street with a live video feed. If you can, please come to the visitation on Tuesday night and attend the overflow service in the Student Center to provide more room in the main sanctuary. We are expecting 600-700 mourners for the service. We are working on a plan to have a nice and efficient visitation in the gym to where as many as possible can pass on their condolences to the family. If you wish to help serve with meals, please reach out to Charlotte Waters or Debbie Baker. We will have two different opportunities to minister to the family with food at service times. Becky Buck is helping to coordinate food being taken to the family the next week. Our Safety Team will assist with parking. If you have any other questions, please contact the church office.

Lastly, we have canceled Sunday's Business Meeting with the possibility of icy road conditions. We will potentially cancel Sunday services, but we will wait until Friday to make a final determination. We will send out a church wide email and post on Facebook if services are canceled.
