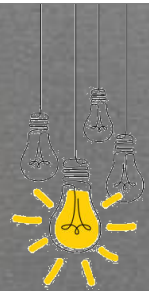

A movement of the Holy Spirit. Have you ever heard someone say that before? You've probably heard me say that before. This past week at camp, we saw the Holy Spirit move. What does that mean? Have you ever wondered investigated what that means? This Sunday at "Worship on The Water", we will hold a worship service at Lake Nasworthy. We have lots of things planned. We will have some breakfast at 10AM, then we will sing praise and worship songs, celebrate a new life with a baby dedication, hear from God's Word, and celebrate those who have made new commitments to Christ with believers' baptism. This past week I meet with a person who has been under conviction of the Holy Spirit for several years but has resisted responding to His conviction. Finally, they responded and are enjoying the fruit of the Holy Spirit's blessing of fruit. Don't wait! The Lord has much to do through you.

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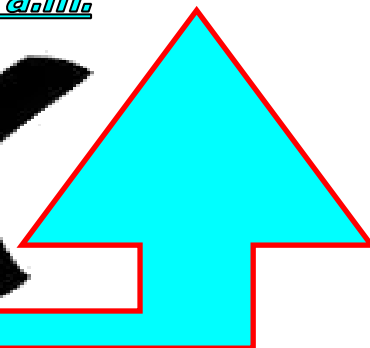

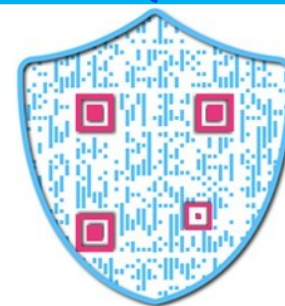
