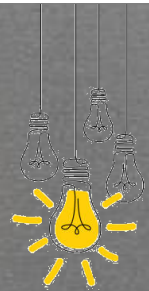

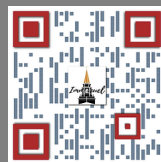


Ministry Opportunities
